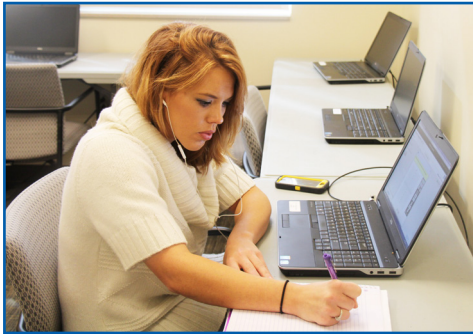


BUSINESS AND COMPUTER SCIENCE



The Department of Business and Computer Science at New River Community and Technical College provides students with in-demand knowledge and skills to meet their educational goals.

Advanced Skill Set Certificates provide training in 14 to 24 academic credit hours. A.S.S.C. programs include: Customer Service Specialist, Computer Software Application Specialist, Computer Support Specialist, Entrepreneurship, Receptionist, Retail Department Manager and Technical Sales Specialist. State and federal financial aid are not available for these programs.

Certificate of Applied Science programs prepare students for employment in 30 to 36 academic credit hours. C.A.S.

programs include: Bookkeeping, Green Entrepreneurship, IT Foundations, Legal Office Assistant, Management and Supervisory Development and Technical Office Procedures and Skills.

Associate of Science programs are designed for students interested in furthering their education after completing their associate degree. Programs range from 60 to 66 academic credit hours. A.S. programs include Business Administration and Computer Science: Information Technology.

Associate of Applied Science programs are career programs focused on providing the skills and knowledge needed for employment. Programs range from 60 to 71 academic credit hours. A.A.S. programs include: Business: Accounting, Business: Management, Business: Office Technology, Computer Science: Healthcare IT Technician and Hospitality and Tourism Management.

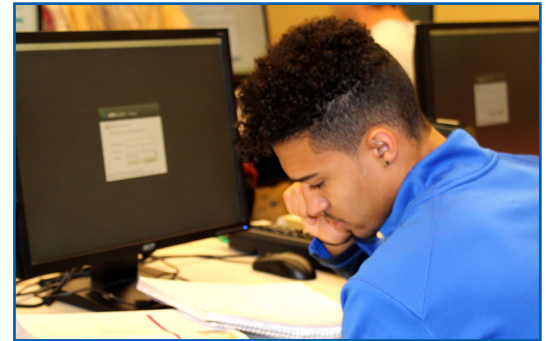
