The Department of Humanities, Social and Behavioral Sciences at New River Community and Technical College offers programs for students looking to enter the workforce after graduation or transfer to a four-year institution.

Certificate of Applied Science programs prepare students for employment. C.A.S. programs range from 30 to 37 academic credit hours. The Paraprofessional Education program is a 37 credit hour program.

Associate of Science programs are designed for students interested in furthering their education after completing their associate degree. Programs range from 60 to 66 academic credit hours. A.S. programs include criminal justice: corrections, criminal justice: forensic investigation, criminal justice: law enforcement and general studies (a program designed to allow students to complete general education requirements prior to transferring to a four-year institution).

Associate of Applied Science programs are career programs focused on providing the skills and knowledge needed for employment. Programs range from 60 to 71 academic credit hours. A.A.S. programs include board of governors (a nontraditional degree completion program for adult learners that evaluates prior learning and training for academic credit), legal assisting, occupational development: child care practitioner, paraprofessional education and social services.
